

What is Revealed in an Internal Growth Analysis?


- Positive Trends invite you to study why something is succeeding, and identify practices or principles which can be applied to other areas.
- **Negative Trends** alert you to identify problems and take corrective action. If the internal trend reflects a change in the community, then the entire church must be led to seek a long-term response.
- Sudden Changes prompt investigation, and often involve the loss of a highly effective person. Such losses tend to provoke a crisis of broken trust for several people, who will need healing.










Did the Sunday Morning Attendance numbers change to reflect the number of Baptisms and Other Additions?

If no Significant changes occurred, the number of Baptisms and Other Additions are not affecting the number attending/leaving the Church...there could be a Problem with Discipleship occurring.




Preschool (Birth – 5 years)




Sunday School Overview Children




Sunday School Overview Youth




Young Adults (18-24)




Young Adults (25-34)












